TOWN OF SOUTHAMPTON BEACH PARKING INFORMATION

Beach Parking Permits are required at all Town Beach Recreation Facilities beginning May 26 thru Labor Day. They may be purchased throughout the season at all Town beaches

- May 26—June 22: Permits are required at Pikes, Ponquogue, Tiana, Foster Memorial (Long Beach), Flying Point and Sagg Main Beaches on weekends.
- June 23—Labor Day, permits will be required 7 days a week at all Town Beaches.
- March 2: Permits are available at the Parks & Recreation Office, 6 Newtown Road, Hampton Bays from 8:30 am—4:00 pm, Monday—Friday.
- May 2—June 23: Permits are available at Town Hall, 116 Hampton Rd, Southampton, 10:00 am—2:00 pm, Monday, Wednesday, Friday
- Permits are non-transferable and must be applied to the vehicle at time of purchase.
 Beaches open full-time/7-days a week starting June 23—Labor Day.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY FOR FULL-SEASON PERMITS

HOMEOWNERS: Current tax bill with the name matching the name on the vehicle registration AND a current vehicle registration with a Town of Southampton address.

YEAR-ROUND RENTERS: Vehicle registration with a town street address along with three (3) utility bills (cable or electric) one current, one dated 6 months prior and one dated 12 months prior.

NOTE: VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS WITH PO BOXES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. LEASES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE AS PROOF OF RESIDENCY.

Unless otherwise posted, lifeguards are on duty, 10:00 am-5:00 pm, when bathing beaches are open.

Permits are required at all times, 9:00 am-9:00 pm, at all Beach Facilities and Town/Trustee Access Roads.

TRUSTEE & TOWN ACCESS ROADS TO THE BEACH

Full-season permits are required at all Trustee/Town Access Roads July 1-Labor Day.
